**Minimum Age to Volunteer 15 Years Old.**

**We are looking for TEEN volunteers to assist at Safety Town in a variety of ways**

### **School Year Scout Program Volunteer – Assist with our weekly safety programs for scouts**

- **Must have early release from school to work this shift.**
- **Tuesdays or Thursdays 3:30 – 5:00 p.m.**
- **Duties:** -Assist with class related activities including bike ride time in our town; Help kids with helmets, bike selection, seat adjustment and clean up at end of program.
- **Physical Requirements:** most duties are performed outdoors and may require lifting of over 20 lbs. Requires frequent bending and pulling and pushing.
- **Equipment:** small hand tools to adjust bike seats. Use of disinfecting spray to clean helmets.
- **Shifts:** Available shifts will be posted online at [www.MyVolunteerPage.com](http://www.MyVolunteerPage.com) for teens to sign up as available for the dates needed.

### **Event Volunteers -Assist with our public, night time events**

#### **Spring and Summer Safety Event – May / June / July**

- Volunteer arrival for event night: 4:30 -5:00 PM
- Volunteer shift – 4:30 -8:15
- On-site parking available behind fire station (no shuttle)
- Teens help with jeep and bike ride time as well as a variety of other activities.

#### **Trick or Treat Event – October**

- > Volunteer arrival for event night: 4:30 -5:00 PM
- > Volunteer shift for event 4:30 -9:30 p.m.
- > No parking on site---plan to be dropped off, use the shuttle or park & walk.
- >Teens help with a variety of duties from candy distribution to safety house helper, to sign holder.

### **Spring Break and Summer Teen Helper - Assist during our public programs**

- Volunteer shift times TBD, but will be Mon-Fri day time hours (when school not in session)
- No parking on site---plan to be dropped off, use the shuttle or park & walk
- Volunteers assist with bike ride time and other activities related to our public programs.
