1. **What is date and time October 26, 2018 6PM-9PM**
2. **What time can we get in line?** People usually start arriving around 4:00 PM.
3. **Can we wear costumes?** Yes, we love that.
4. **Will there be food?** Yes, the Methodist Men will be selling grilled food for a small price. Bottled water will be for sale also.
5. **Will you still have it if it rains?** Yes - we are a rain or shine event. We have plans for the line to move into the apparatus bay if it is raining.
6. **What about parking?** NO on site parking; We encourage visitors to use our Free Shuttle Bus at the Frisco Athletic Center at 5828 Nancy Jane Lane (near the intersection of Wade Blvd. & Preston Rd.) For those with placards, there is a controlled access handicapped parking area reserved in front of Central Administration.

8. **Will you have face painting?** NO, we will have a temporary tattoo station but no face painting.

Guests in the past have told us they were in line for 45 minutes or less when it was at its longest (across the street into our fleet services parking lot.)

10. **Will the clowns be there?** Yes, our Fire Clowns will be on hand for the event!
