Thank you for registering to volunteer at Frisco Fire Safety Town. Please complete the required online registration. Once registered, you can log into your volunteer account to sign up for future events and volunteer opportunities, log your hours after you work, update your information and even contact me. Please complete all requested information! Thank you.

If you are already registered to volunteer with the City of Frisco but you have never volunteer with the Frisco Fire Dept. or Safety Town, you will need to add us as an organization.

You can use the following instructions to either complete a new application for new volunteers or add Frisco FD/FF Safety Town as an organization to existing City of Frisco volunteers.

Go to www.MyVolunteerPage.com.

Type in Frisco in the county, city or town box. **Click Search.**


