Ride Time Information

Event F.A.Q. 's

1. **Who can ride?** All jeep drivers and bicycle riders must be at least 40 inches tall; Jeep passengers must be at least 2 years of age to participate. Max height for jeep is 48”.
2. **What time is first jeep/bike ride time?** First jeep ride time is 5:15, last jeep ride time is 6:15. Bike ride time is from 6:30 – 7:00.
3. **How long do we get to ride?** A maximum of 10 minutes for jeeps and training wheel bikes due to high demand/limited inventory. We are not planning for ‘second rides’ for jeep time to allow all visitors an opportunity for a first ride.
4. **Can we bring our own bikes?** We do NOT allow bikes to be brought into the event. Additionally, you may not bring motorized cars, scooters, tricycles, push cars, roller blades, or skateboards, wagons, etc. We have 20” and 24” bikes; And several of the 20” have training wheels.
5. **Can we bring our own helmet?** Yes. A helmet is required to ride a bike. We have plenty but visitors are welcome to bring their own.
6. **What should I wear?** We recommend PE attire for kids and **closed toe shoes for ALL** kids and parents for safety during ride time.
7. **Can adults ride bikes, too?** Unfortunately, we do not have bikes large enough and do not offer rides to adults. Our bikes are sized for elementary aged children.
8. **Can we enter early if the event starts at 5:00?** We are not scheduling any visits after noon on Friday to allow time to set up for the event. Our line will form outside the front/main entrance. We will seat the first jeep review class at 5:00 PM.
9. **Where do I park?** Anywhere around Central Station or Fire Prevention/Fleet Services on Tomlin St. Parking is on a first come-first served basis. There is NO shuttle provided for offsite parking.
10. **What if it rains? Our event will go on RAIN OR SHINE.** If weather does not permit, outdoor activities will be cancelled, but the event will continue with all indoor activities.
11. **Can we go in the little buildings?** Visitors will be able to enjoy self-paced activities in select village buildings.

JEEPS - Start Times Run Every 15 Minutes: 5:15-6:15 PM

BIKES-Open Ride from 6:30 -7:00 PM

Friday Nights Only – May 13, June 10, & July 8

1. All riders must be a minimum of 40 inches tall to drive/ride either a jeep or bike. Maximum height to fit in a jeep is 48 inches.
2. All children must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
3. Any jeep passenger under 40 inches must be at least 2 years old to ride.
4. All jeep drivers/bike riders should wear **closed toe shoes** for safety.
5. All riders & their accompanying parent/guardian must watch a Jeep Guidelines Review video to obtain your ticket to ride.
6. There will be a limited number of rides available at each ride time due to a limited number of jeeps.
7. An adult must stay with a child's jeep for the duration of his/her ride time. We ask for **no cell phone use during jeep monitoring**.
8. Rides will be offered on a first come - first served basis and riders will be offered a 10 minute ride around the mini-town.
9. Jeep & bike riders will travel around the town and will be expected to stop at stops signs and red lights.
10. Bike riders must wear a helmet. We do have an ample supply but visitors are welcome to bring their own.
11. Visitors **may not bring** motorized cars, scooters, tricycles, push cars, skateboards, wagons, other other wheeled ride-on toy.
12. Parents should plan to be with their child during ride time; If you have younger siblings in strollers, please plan to bring an additional adult to assist your child with the jeep.
13. To be eligible to ride a bike, the child must be able to touch the ground with the front half of his/her feet.
